The Cadet Contract & Understanding

Please carefully read the following contract and understanding of the Air Force JROTC program.

9. Contractual Agreement Between The U.S. Air Force & Dorchester District 2

- 1) Voluntary enrollment will be limited to physically fit students in 9th-12th grade who meet and maintain acceptable standards of academic achievement, personal conduct, and personal appearance in accordance with The U.S. Air Force.*
- 2) Cadets will wear the prescribed uniform a minimum of one day per week while attending all classes and while participating in out-of-class AF JROTC activities. Cadets will follow and adhere to all Air Force uniform standards.*
- 3) The Air Force JROTC program DOES NOT discriminate in participation against students or instructors on the basis of race, color, religion, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), national origin, political affiliation, sexual orientation, disability, genetic information, age, parental status, other non-merit factor.*

10. Cadet Health & Wellness Understanding

- 1) Cadets will be in reasonably good physical condition. Capable of standing in formation, marching, and running.*
- 2) Cadets will have an Air Force JROTC Health/Wellness Program Participation Consent Health Screening Questionnaire and Sports Physical as directed by Dorchester District 2 on file within the first 30 days of school.*
- 3) Cadets are required to participate in physical fitness training (PT) which includes strength training and cardiovascular exercise. Other PT activities like football, basketball, and volleyball will be incorporated when possible.*
- 4) Cadets are required to wear the AF JROTC Unit PT Uniform when participating in PT events. Failure to wear the Unit PT uniform on assigned days will result in a 0% PT grade and will not be allowed to participate.*
- 5) Refusal to participate in the PT program will govern a failing grade and continued refusal may initiate a referral to school administration for disenrollment from the AF JROTC program.*

11. Cadet Grooming & Appearance Standards

- 1) Cadets are required to wear the Air Force JROTC uniform once a week on the specified uniform day for a graded uniform inspection. The graded uniform inspection is a major part of the academic grade. The uniform will be worn for the entire school day. (For example: A cadet will wear the uniform leaving home to school and back home.)*
- 2) Cadets who fail to wear their uniform on an assigned day without a valid excuse will receive an academic grade of 0%. Refusal to wear the uniform will govern a failing grade and continued refusal may initiate a referral to school administration for disenrollment from the AF JROTC program.*

3) Cadets will follow and adhere to the Air Force instructions on personal grooming standards while wearing the Air Force uniform.

4) Cadets will learn personal grooming standards and proper uniform wear in class during the first few weeks of school.

12. Cadet Attitude & Conduct Understanding

1) Cadets are required to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner at all times, not just in AF JROTC class.

2) Cadets will follow ALL school and AF JROTC rules and professionally respect ALL teachers and cadets.

3) Any blatant disrespect of rules dictated by the school district, school, AF JROTC program, and/or local laws can be grounds for dismissal from the Air Force JROTC program following a review by school administration.

4) Cadets will read and sign a "Cadet Pledge" and "Cadet Honor Code" during the first week of class. Cadets who violate the code, "A cadet will not lie, cheat, or steal, nor tolerate among us those who do" can be removed from AF JROTC. Removal from AF JROTC during the school year will likely result in the cadet receiving NO credit for that school year.

13. Other Cadet Expectations

1) Cadets are required to pay the Unit Registration Fee of \$35.

2) The Black Unit Polo is a mandatory uniform item. The cost will be \$25 each.

3) Cadets are required to accomplish 6 community service hours per quarter. An academic grade will be given based on completion of community service hours per quarter.

4) Cadets will be required to attend 4 events that occur outside of school hours. Dates & Time will be announced once confirmed:
- Commanders Call - Air Force JROTC Family Night - Pass-In-Review (time & date to be determined) - Headquarters Air Force JROTC Unit Inspection (time & date to be determined)

5) The Cadet Handbook goes into more details of cadet requirements and unit activities. The handbook will be available in the classroom and published on the Unit Website.
